



32nd IMSC Ambassador Program Rules

- 1. The aim of 32nd IMSC Ambassador Program is to promote the Conference and share the information about the IMSC among the medical students.
- The Ambassador agreement is signed between a Person who wants to become the Ambassador and accepts the rules of the Program and the representative of IMSC Organizing Committee.
- 3. Both Ambassadors and the Organizing Committee are obliged to fulfill their obligations included in the contract.
- 4. The obligations of the Ambassadors' are:
 - a. Promote the IMSC,
 - b. Invite possible participants for IMSC,
 - c. Properly represent the IMSC.
- 5. The obligations of Organizing Committee are:
 - a. Deliver promotional materials to the Ambassador.
 - b. Inform the Ambassador about the information they should convey.
 - c. Provide free fee for the Ambassadors who <u>successfully</u>* invite <u>at least 10</u> <u>participants</u> of the IMSC.
 - d. Provide the priority during workshops and social program registration for the Ambassadors who <u>successfully</u> invite <u>at least 10 participants</u> of the IMSC.
 - e. Provide additionally free access to the Gala Dinner for Ambassadors who successfully invite <u>at least 15 participants</u> of the IMSC.
- 6. Other obligations might be added by bilateral agreement.
- 7. All issues not mentioned in the rules are solved by the discussion and bilateral agreement.

*Successful invitation means that the invited person takes part in the Conference.
