

## 32nd IMSC Clinical Competition Rules

1. The aim of the Competition is to confront the knowledge and skills of other students from different Universities and to increase the medical knowledge of the participants.
2. The subject area of the Competition during the 32nd edition is **emergency medicine**. Most of the questions and tasks of the Competition will be concerned with this area.
3. Participants of the Competition compete in 6-person teams.
4. It is not necessary to create interdisciplinary teams (the variety of biomedical faculties), but it is strongly recommended.
5. Participants can apply for the Competition only in teams.
6. The maximum number of participating teams is 15. In case of a higher number of applications, the order of applications will decide or there will be an additional qualification round in the form of an online test.
7. **All active or passive participants** of the 32nd IMSC, being students of biomedical faculties, might participate in the Competition.
8. The Competition will take place during the 32nd IMSC, on the 16-18<sup>th</sup> May 2024 at the Jagiellonian University Medical College.
9. **The Competition will consist of 2 parts:**
  - a. Theoretical (test)
  - c. Practical
10. Competition tasks and questions will be created and evaluated by Jury constituted by the Scientific Committee of IMSC.
11. During the theoretical part participants will answer test questions.
12. Only 4 best teams (judging by their score on theoretical part of competition) will take part in practical round of competition.
13. The practical round will consist of the Emergency Department simulation and basic life support (BLS) as well as advanced life support (ALS) skills evaluation.
13. Only the best team (1<sup>st</sup> place) will be awarded with monetary or in-kind prizes.
14. The results will be announced on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2024 during the award ceremony.
15. More precise rules and guidelines of the Competition will be announced to the participants before the Competition.
16. Questions and tasks will be based on the current medical guidelines and knowledge.
17. All issues not included in the Rules will be decided by the Organizing Committee.
